Subject: Special surveillance measures for arrivals from Mumbai and Maharashtra - Regarding.


Reference : 1. Even number Revised circular, Dated: 31.7.2021
2. Recommendations of 132nd meeting of State Covid 19 Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), dated 6-11-2021.

As per the subject and references cited above, the data emerging from Karnataka and Maharashtra though shows a vast improvement in Covid 19 situation, the daily case load & Test Positivity Rate are slightly higher in Maharashtra compared to Karnataka Therefore, the following addendum is issued with the following inclusions, for short term travelers (2days or less) from Maharashtra including Mumbai to Karnataka by any mode of transport, i.e., Road, Railways, Airways .

All the passengers arriving shall:

- Be asymptomatic like free from fever, cough, cold, throat pain, fever, difficulty in breathing, etc.
- Give a self-declaration on the same, to effect while boarding.
- Compulsorily undergo thermal scanning for fever on arrival.
- Carry Covid 19 vaccination completion certificate for both the two doses.
- Compulsorily wear face mask & follow the Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB) throughout their stay in Bangalore and Karnataka.
- Produce a valid return ticket.

Further, persons complying the above norms strictly, may be exempted from mandatory RT-PCR negative test report for short duration of visit. Therefore, the concerned authorities are instructed to ensure the same, in the larger interest of Public Health.
